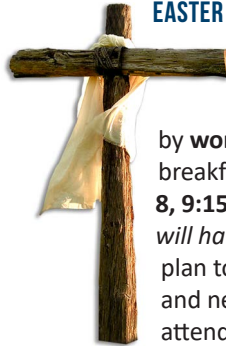

Because of Spring Break, Wednesday evening classes will not meet on March 29. Classes will resume April 5. Women in the Word will not meet on March 29.

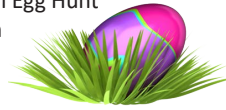
