

How Can You Say That?

Week 1: God is real and God is good. In week one, we will talk about proofs for the existence of God. More than that, though, we want students to also know that God is good. If God is good, then we can trust Him to have our best interests in mind, and we can trust that He is telling us the truth about the world we live in right now. This is a key and foundational truth that we hope every student will believe!

Week 3: God reveals truth in the Bible. So many things in our world point to the glory of God—creation, people, music, and more. Yet, the Bible holds a special place in our lives as a written story of God working in the world and of God revealing himself to people. This message will explore why we can trust the Bible and how it demonstrates to us truth that God wants us to know.

Week 2: God defines what is right/wrong. God is good and loving, and he is also our creator. And because God is the creator of the world, He is the one who defines what is true for us. Ultimately, this brings us a great deal of hope and comfort because it means that we can *know* things. Life does not simply have to be an empty search for meaning, but rather something we approach with confidence because of God's statements of what is true.

Week 4: God is present and working now. Sometimes God feels distant or we act like He did work in the past and then disappeared on us. However, God is present with every student and is doing work in ways we do not even realize. With this final part of the series, we hope to encourage students to approach God with faith, believing that God is present in all things!
