

**Life Group Questions**  
**“Faith in Philippi”**  
**Acts 16:6-40**

**Opener:** Take 2 minutes and share how the Lord opened your heart to respond to the gospel? What people did he use as part of the process?

**Read the passage.**

1. What do verses 6-10 tell you about the role of the Holy Spirit?
2. Read 16:9-10. If you were falsely accused, severely beaten, and thrown into a dark jail would you still trust that God had called to go to this place? Why or why not?
3. Look at verse 19. This is the third time in the book of Acts where financial greed has caused opposition to the gospel. What financial concerns, do you think keep people from faith today? Are any of these concerns a factor for you? Discuss.
4. Paul and Silas were singing hymns in a difficult situation and it had a lasting impact on those around them (v. 25). How might we do things in our daily living that will impact those around us for the benefit of the Kingdom?
5. In what ways does the jailer express his new faith in Jesus?
6. If asked, “What must I do to be saved?”, how would you answer?
7. In this passage we see how faith is demonstrated by action. How would God have you display your faith this week?
